WATERCOLOR PAINT IN TUBES ARTIST GRADE

(Winsor Newton, Daniel Smith, M. Graham are all good brands and available at Nevada Fine Arts)

Quinacrodone Red, Transparent Yellow (or Nickel Azo Yellow by M. Graham, Da Vinci or Daniel Smith), Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna, Indigo. (Optional additional colors: Cobalt Blue, Antwerp Blue, Quinacrodone Rose or Permanent Rose, Opera Rose, Quinacrodone Gold, Peacock Blue by Holbein.)

BRUSHES

1.5" or 2" FLAT WASH BRUSH (Cheap hog hair or Hake brush ok)

½" flat or angled brush (I prefer a Dagger – for sale at NFA)

Size 4 or 6 round watercolor brush

Size 12 or 14 round watercolor brush

Size 1 or 2 round detail brush

Size 2 Rigger or Script brush (small brush with long hairs)

PAPER:

140 lb or 300lb Arches cold-pressed watercolor paper, ¼ full-sheet or larger (4 pieces) Arches Watercolor block Ok

Watercolor sketch book (optional)

Miscellaneous Supplies:

Color palette w/lid (I like Jane E Jones Travel palette w/Lid Available at NFA)

2 Large water containers

Old towel for blotting,

Support board (foam board ok)

Paper towel, Kleenex, Scissors, x-acto knife

Pencil, Kneaded Eraser, Spray Bottle, Masking Fluid & Masking Tape, Rubber Cement Eraser to pick up Masking fluid.
